

Waukesha Gun Club
Sportsman's Thursday Night Handicap League
2008

1. There is 16 weeks of handicap targets; 50 birds each week. A 7 man team roster (optional 8), with 5 shooters each night (optional 6) only five scores count; on all team sheets.
2. Cost of shooting will be \$16.00 per week for members and \$18.00 per week for non-members for targets and banquet fees. Waukesha Gun Club will provide scorers and post all the league scores on team sheets on the bulletin board in the clubhouse.
3. The first 4 weeks will be shot for classification as follows: Shooters are allowed to shoot ahead a maximum of two weeks, but not from behind the given week. Any 5 team members will shoot three weeks or more in the first 4 weeks . The first week all shooting will be done from 22 yards. The next 3 weeks all teams' yardage will be determined by their score the previous week as follows:

236 – 250	27 yards	181 – 190	22 yards
221 – 235	26 yards	171 – 180	21 yards
211 – 220	25 yards	161 – 170	20 yards
201 – 220	24 yards	0 – 160	19 yards
191 – 200	23 yards		

4. After 4 weeks, teams will be divided into classes with approximately 4 teams in each class, depending on how many teams there are in the league. For the remainder of the season, a team's yardage will be determined by its standings in its class. The first class will have a minimum of 27 yards, and the last class will have a minimum of 19 yards. Classification will be on a total bird's basis. However, a team may be put in a higher class based on known ability. Winning teams in each class is to be determined by total birds broken.
5. If a team shoots with less than 5 people, the missing score(s) will be 5 birds less than the team's average for that night. If a shooter cannot finish the league, the captain may designate another shooter to take their place. The league management must approve the new shooter.

6. This is a team league and teams will shoot together as a squad at given times on per half hour. Shooting will be done on traps 3,4,5,6. Starting at 5:00pm, and the last squads will be starting by 7:30pm.
7. All shooting will be done according to ATA rules and guidelines.
8. There will be a banquet for all shooters at the end of the season. At a cost of \$20 per person on each team for food and prizes, plus the \$3 per week extra. All payments of banquet money made to Waukesha Gun Club. If you have any questions about this, please contact Ron Rousseau at 262-547-7287 or the club at 262-547-9785.
9. League champion is determined by a shoot-off among all class winners, from the maximum yardage of their class. This will be held the week following the regular season, starting at 6:00pm.
10. All shooters are eligible for High-Gun if 12 or more scores are shot, each class will have a High Gun winner (league committee decisions are final).

Note: An optional \$5.00 Lewis Class purse will be available weekly, offered by the Waukesha Gun Club by the Lewis Class Description Rules posted.
